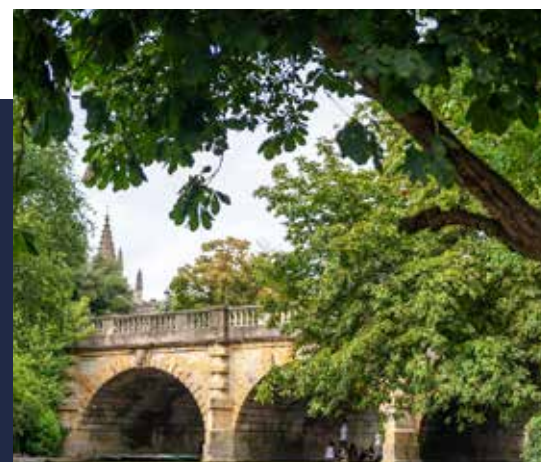
Time to Shine

Essential Medical Skills: The Fundamentals of Emergency Care

Headington's Future Doctors will take part in a teamwork project in which they will learn fundamental skills in emergency care, such as suturing (i.e. applying stitches), measuring vital signs (e.g. heart rate, pulse, blood pressure and blood oxygen levels) and attending to cuts and wounds. As part of the Time to Shine project, all Headington Future Doctor students will receive a full First Aid training course from a qualified trainer, and receive an authentic First Aid certificate at the end of their course.
