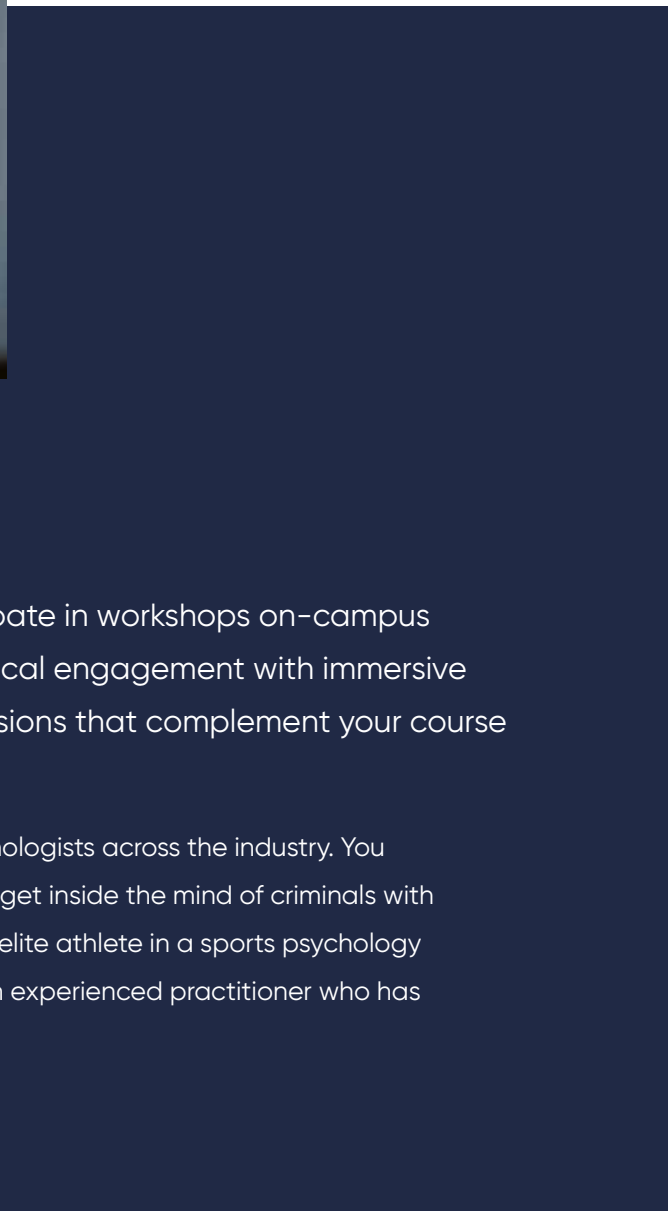
Unlocking Human Behaviour
