Horse Riding

ORS SUMMER SCHOOL

Students of all abilities can select the English Plus Horse Riding option. Students will ride horses in the beautiful New Forest, approximately 30 minutes from Canford. Beginners will be taught the basics of horse riding, while more advanced students will go on a hacking route. Afterwards, students will have the opportunity to learn about horse care and get involved in looking after the ponies.

This course aims to develop our students':

Communication

Students will learn how to give effective signals to the horses, reading signals back in return

Balance

Students will develop their sense of balance necessary to ride a horse

Patience and growth mindset

Students will practice learning new skills and improving their abilities through continually putting in effort

Independence

Students will improve their confidence in their own abilities to direct the horse by themselves

Responsibility

Students will have the opportunity to take part in caring for the horses, learning what is needed to look after an animal in their care and instilling a sense of accountability and respect for animals and the natural world

Sessions will be led by a qualified British Horse Riding instructor, and at least one member of SBC staff will accompany the group.
